HYLAND HILLS WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION (18-Hole) GENERAL INFORMATION – 2023

- League play days are on **Tuesdays and Thursdays.** Members can play either day or both days!
- We play **18 holes on the Gold Course** at Hyland Hills in Westminster, Colorado: www.golfhylandhills.com
- Our season begins May 1 and ends September 30
- Tee times normally begin at 8:00 AM in May & September and at 7:30 AM in June, July & August
- Players sign up for tournaments via our Golf Genius portal
- Tee times are normally assigned on Tuesdays. Members may sign up for their own tee times on Thursdays. Outside guests are also allowed on Thursdays
- We are a "social" group but play according to the USGA Rules of Golfalong with a few local rules
- We are a member of the Colorado Golf Association (CGA) and use the WHS (World Handicap System) for handicap purposes
- Dues do not include green fees
- Two Membership meetings are held each year one in the Spring and one in the Fall
- New Members may participate in Inter-League competitions: Northern Golf League/A-team or Northern Scenic League/B Team
- New Members are not eligible to participate in Club Championship, Most Improved Golfer, or the CGA Club Team event

New Member Requirements:

- Players with an established USGA handicap that converts to a 40 or less course handicap on the 18-Hole Gold
 Course at Hyland Hills may join the Association once they have completed an application and paid the dues
 and initiation fee.
- New members who have a previous knowledge of golf, but do not have a USGA handicap, may establish a temporary 18-hole handicap by submitting (to the Handicap Chairperson) scorecards for a total of 54 holes (any combination of 9-hole or 18-hole rounds signed, dated, and attested from any USGA rated golf course. These rounds must have been played within the previous twelve (12) months. One (1) of these rounds must be played on the Hyland Hills 18-Hole Gold Course with a current member of the Association. A Handicap Index will be calculated from these rounds. If it converts to a 40 or less course handicap, the new member will be accepted. If not accepted, the dues and initiation fee will be refunded.
