Please note that you should return your membership application as soon as possible so we may complete our membership roster. **The deadline for the return of the membership application is Wednesday, March 15th, 2023.** All applications received after that date will incur a **\$15.00 LATE FEE**. If you know any golfers, men or women who would like to join the **best** Senior Golf Club around, please give one of the board members a call or better yet direct them to our website where there is an interactive application.

Hole-In-One Insurance: Everyone who wants to participate in 2023 needs to pay their \$5 with application, since there was a winner in 2022.

We will be having the **Spring General Meeting** and so far, Four (4) luncheons are being planned so far for 2023 including the Spring and end of year meetings. The Spring General Meeting and luncheon will be **Monday, April 18th** and our **Fall Banquet, October 2nd**. Updates or changes will be sent out via email and posted on our new website. Look for the automatic sign-up email. This is another reason to return your application ASAP.

All members are required to have a GHIN number.

- When an individual applies for membership and has a current USGA GHIN number and their Course Handicap on the Hyland Hills Gold Course is 40 or less they will be admitted to the Club. Based on their course handicap they will be assigned to the appropriate Flight. If the individual's Course Handicap on the Gold Course is greater than 40 their application will not be accepted, and their membership fee will be returned.
- When an individual applies for membership and does not have a current USGA GHIN number, the Club will obtain one for them. Their Course Handicap will be calculated based on the average of the first 5 rounds played in Club tournaments (excluding scrambles). If that Course

Handicap exceeds 40 they will not be eligible for membership and their membership dues will be refunded to them on a pro-rata basis. Until the applicant establishes a Course Handicap they will be given a zero handicap and assigned to the A Flight.

- If you have a current USGA GHIN number, with a handicap of 40 or less, contact the Tournament Chairperson and that number will be used as your handicap for tournament play.
- Any member who has not posted a tournament score in two (2) years must re-establish a handicap prior to being eligible for tournament winnings.
- Any member starting the season without a handicap will be put into the A Flight with a "0" handicap" until a handicap is established.
- Handicaps will be updated on a monthly basis

Sign-up for tournaments through Golf Genius will be the same as last year.

Last year the Golf Genius real-time mobile app was used to enter scores. We hope we can continue this in 2023 with 100% participation. This requires someone to have a phone in each 4-some. A mobile app code is posted on the scorecard that is entered before the round. Do not use your personal login. Look for this ICON when installing the app on your phone. We will go over this again at the spring meeting...



Prior to the first day of play, Members are encouraged to read the information on the Website. It will contain the tournament schedule (dates and times), the revised Standing Rules, the Bylaws, the updated Membership Roster and other important information.
